She specializes in educational support specialist education and teacher education for inclusion. Her research interest includes special needs and inclusive education, and early childhood intervention. She has an extensive expertise in special needs education and developments towards inclusive education acquired through national and international research projects.

Main focus

The presentation focuses on the issue of on-going transition from a traditional teacher-dominated to a learner-dominated paradigm that requires a major shift in the culture of Higher Education towards much greater personal involvement of learners in the design implementation and evaluation of their own personalized learning journey.

By employing participatory approaches that emphasize the personalization of learning it is also intended to support teacher educators and their students to address issues of social and cultural equity, diversity and inclusion in education.



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
