Summary of the action

Le Rhin Supérieur présente actuellement des taux de chômage très variables de part et d'autre de la frontière. Les données actuelles illustrent bien la complémentarité des marchés du travail : le Bade-Wurtemberg et le Nord-Ouest de la Suisse, deux régions économiquement prospères ont des besoins de main d'œuvre très importants dans le secteur de la production et de la fabrication pour le Bade-Wurtemberg et dans les secteurs des sciences de la vie (Life Sciences), de la santé et de l'artisanat pour le Nord ouest de la Suisse. La partie alsacienne de l'Alsace Champagne-Ardenne Lorraine détient, quant à elle, une main d'œuvre jeune et qualifiée.

Le marché du travail transfrontalier revêt donc un caractère essentiel permettant d'encourager l'adéquation entre les demandeurs d'emploi et les postes vacants de part et d'autre de la frontière. Afin d'utiliser les forces en présence et de créer une offre de services complète sur tout le territoire, avec les mêmes standards de qualité, les services du plan d'activités 2017 d'EURES-T Rhin Supérieur agissent en complémentarité avec ceux des agences pour l'emploi, conformément aux axes du catalogue de services EURES suivants :

- pré-recrutement (section A)
- recrutement/mise en adéquation/placement (sections A et B)
- informations et conseils (sections A et B)
- coopération transfrontalière (section E)
- informations sur les conditions de vie et de travail dans les divers pays et les avantages de travailler dans un autre pays.

Summary of the action

The creation of the EURES Crossborder North Portugal - Galicia service in December 1997 followed the common objective and commitment of the partner bodies towards improving the situation of the labour market of Galicia and North Portugal, creating a transparent employment market and developing a system of cooperation and collaboration between the public employment services and all other economic and social agents representing the Euro-region with potential ability to facilitate and boost the crossborder mobility of workers and employers.

EURES-T G-NP has become a reference structure in the Euro-region with respect to knowledge of rights and obligations relative to the crossborder mobility of workers and entrepreneurs. Moreover, it operates as a meeting point for entities and institutions concerning mobility.

The bodies included in the structure of EURES Crossborder Galicia-North Portugal have undertaken among one another and before the Commission to jointly pursue the following objectives based on Commission Decision 2012/733/EU of 26 November 2012, in conformity with their responsibilities at a crossborder level:

- a)The development of an open and accessible crossborder employment market, in strict observance with the applicable labour laws and legal requirements;
- b)Adjustment and placement at a crossborder scale, through the exchange of job offers and search, and participation in the specific mobility activities organised in the context of the EU;
- c)Transparency and exchange of information on the labour market of the Euro-region, in particular on living and working conditions and opportunities for the acquisition of skills;
- d)The development of measures to boost and facilitate the mobility of young workers;
- e)The exchange of information on professional internships and apprenticeships, and their implementation.

For the pursuit of the general objectives, the bodies integrated in the structure undertake will provide Services of the E-Charter.

Summary of the action

Die Grenzpartnerschaft EURES-TriRegio setzt sich aus Vertretern der Arbeitsverwaltungen, der Gewerkschaften und der Arbeitgeberorganisationen aus Sachsen, Böhmen und Niederschlesien zusammen.

Sie wurde von den Partnern seit der Integration Polens und Tschechiens in die Europäische Union im Jahre 2004 vorbereitet und hat sich mit der Unterzeichnung der Rahmenvereinbarung im Oktober 2007 konstituiert. Sie betrachtet die Integration der Arbeits- und Ausbildungsmärkte im Dreiländereck als die wesentliche Gestaltungsaufgabe. Ihr langfristiges Ziel ist es, unter Einhaltung der bestehenden Arbeits- und Sozialstandards des jeweiligen Landes die Entwicklung eines gemeinsamen Arbeitsmarktes zu fördern.

Zu den Handlungsschwerpunkten gehören: Projekte zur Vermittlung von Arbeitsstellen in der Region; Information und Beratung durch die EURES-Beraterinnen und –Berater; Bereitstellung von aktuellen und zielgruppenspezifischen Informations- und Beratungsangeboten für Arbeitgeber, Arbeitnehmer, Selbständige, Auszubildende, Studenten und Jugendlichen vor der Berufswahl; Initiativen zur Durchsetzung von fairer Mobilität im Dreiländereck.

Im Förderzeitraum 2017 setzt die EURES-TriRegio die Aktivitäten für Jugendliche und Schulabgänger fort, hierbei die ist Stärkung der dualen Ausbildung auf dem grenzüberschreitenden Arbeitsmarkt Ziel. Mehrere Aktivitäten beziehen die Arbeitgeber, auch aus dem tschechischen und polnischen Teil der Partnerschaft, stärker ein. Die Angebote richten an kleine und mittlere Unternehmen. Die Zusammenarbeit im Rahmen des Kontaktpunktes der EURES-TriRegio wird fortgesetzt. Hierzu gehört die vereinfachte Kontaktaufnahme zur Partnerschaft über den einheitlichen Ansprechpartner und die Internetseite der Partnerschaft, sowie die verstärkte Zusammenarbeit und Koordination der Beratungstätigkeit zwischen den EURES-Beratern und anderen lokalen Arbeitsmarktakteuren, wie Sozialversicherungsträger, Finanzbehörden oder Branchengewerkschaften.

Summary of the action

Im Rahmen dieser Maßnahme wird eine EU-Finanzierung für die euregionale und bilaterale Zusammenarbeit in den Grenzregionen beantragt, die die bestehenden Dienstleistungen der Partner optimiert und stärkt sowie diese über das bisherige Maß hinaus koordiniert und ausbaut. Im Rahmen dieser Maßnahme wird eine EU-Finanzierung für die euregionale und bilaterale Zusammenarbeit in den Grenzregionen beantragt, die die bestehenden Dienstleistungen der Partner optimiert und stärkt sowie diese über das bisherige Maß hinaus koordiniert und ausbaut. EMR, ERW, erm, EUREGIO: Die Maßnahme beinhaltet alle Aktivitäten der Partner im angegebenen Zeitraum. Ziel ist es, die Transparenz des grenzüberschreitenden Arbeitsmarktes zu fördern, die Chancen der Arbeitssuchenden auf dem Markt zu erhöhen und die Arbeitgeber bei ihren Einstellungsmaßnahmen zu unterstützen. Gegenstand sind die Serviceangebote der Partner in Bezug auf das grenzüberschreitende Matching, Information und Beratung der mobilen Arbeitssuchenden, Grenzgänger und Unternehmen im Bezirk der Euregios. Zentrales Ziel der Maßnahme ist es "Menschen in ein Beschäftigungsverhältnis zu bringen und Arbeitsplätze zu sichern" und so einen Beitrag zu mehr Beschäftigung zu leisten. So sollen die Transparenz des euregionalen Arbeitsmarktes gefördert werden, die Nachfrage und das Angebot optimal aufeinander abgestimmt werden und Mobilitätshemmnisse durch eine breiter angelegte Zusammenarbeit mit den Institutionen, die für Steuern, soziale Sicherheit und Arbeitsrecht zuständig sind, gemindert werden. Außerdem geht es darum:

- die Zusammenarbeit mit anderen Organisationen in Belangen des Arbeitsmarktes zu optimieren, insbesondere mit den für Sozialversicherung, Steuern und Arbeitsrecht zuständigen Stellen
- die Zielgruppen über die Serviceangebote zu informieren
- das Personalwesen und das Netzwerk der EURES-Partner zu erweitern
- die Ergebnisse des Arbeitsplans nachzuhalten, zu evaluieren und zu bewerten

Summary of the action

The cross border partnership is established in line with article 3.7 of the Eures regulation and a full list of the Eures Members, Eures partners as well as other relevant actors on the cross border labour market is provided. Activities are organised within the consortium and focus on the promotion of cross-border labour market mobility. The partnership has been organising activities for > 8 years and has experienced that in general the activities attract an adequate engagement from the public and policy makers and still fulfil a need within the cross-border labour market. The principle aims of the partnership focus on the integration of the labour market at cross border level and the voluntary and geographical mobility within the cross border labour market on a fair basis and in compliance with EU & national law and practice. A particular focus is placed on the increased opportunities for job seekers and employers when the labour market scope is enlarged and the other side of the border is included. Specifically in 2017 we will extend the activities and focus on social and labour market experimentation via the provision of training supporting cross-border mobility for jobseekers and the development of mixed cross-border recruitment teams to facilitate the access to job vacancies for jobseekers and CVs for employers. Main focus is the exposure of the untapped resources on the cross-border labour market. Furthermore a research project will be set up focussing on a review of the HR challenges of the moment and the near future on the cross border labour market from the employers perspective will be instigated. Could a re-alignment of services get more employers/non users of Eures services on board? The small scale analysis of cross border placements via a customer survey including evaluation of the usage of the available labour market tools will be continued.

Summary of the action

The mission of EURES Cross Border Partnership is to support frontier and cross border workers, jobseekers and employers in the Ireland/Northern Ireland Border region by raising and improving awareness of the cross border labour market, the benefits of mobility in the EU and to help employers, workers, jobseekers and job changers in this Border region to capitalise on the opportunities offered through their access to a cross border labour market in the border region of the Island of Ireland and the free recruitment service that the EURES Cross Border Partnership and the wider European network can provide.

The Action Plan for 2017 aims to ensure that the Partnership will continue to provide a wide range of services to our target groups on both sides of the Border to encourage and facilitate job placement and recruitment opportunities in the region, to try and overcome some of the obstacles that exist, to keep cross border workers well informed and encourage cross border labour market movement. In keeping with Regulation (EU) 2016/589 a strengthened focus on employer engagement & support, job matching and placement and evaluation are central to the 2017 Action plan.

This Border region has had many challenges in recent decades including violent civil conflict, divided communities and high levels of unemployment, particularly among young people in all communities, 15% in IE, 16% in NI. The region has moved on from its recent history of violent conflict and communities are committed to working together in practical ways and to achieving a flow of opportunity and trade in both directions across our border. This remains a work in progress and it is important to continue to advance areas of practical cooperation and improve the often fragile links and relationships which can make a real difference to the lives of people residing and working in this Cross Border region.

Summary of the action

Euradria 2017 is a set of actions aimed at promoting a fair, legal and profitable geographical mobility and the employment opportunities of the job market spanning across the Euradria region, i.e. the area across Italy, Slovenia and Croatia. The backbone of the action is reinforcing the role, operability and outreach to the selected target groups by the already established Eures Euradria networking, giving thus sustainability to the actions already accomplished in previous EaSI funded projects. In its effort to promote voluntary mobility of the individuals in the cross border labour market, contributing to the implementation of the Eures services in the area and boosting employment opportunities in the cross border area, Euradria operates by setting up specific mobility scheme for traineeships; enhances the role and operability of the Eures services both for actual and potential frontier workers and for the employers in the cross border area; contributes to the improvement of the quality of the cross border job market by analyzing the concrete impact of real and perceived obstacles to mobility faced every day by frontier workers and sets up for the first time an effective framework of cooperation among the tax and social security authorities in the cross border area, in order to concretely proceed to the removal of these obstacles.

Summary of the action

The ETUC is ensuring the coordination of the participation of the trade unions and in particular the Interregional trade Union Councils (IRTUCs) in the EURES Network.

With the adoption of the EURES Regulation our involvement is also at national level (in addition to the European level in the EURES Coordination Group and at regional level in the EURES Cross Border Partnerships). The ETUC coordination is consequently focusing on the monitoring of the involvement of the trade unions in the National Coordination Offices (NCOs).

In addition to that the ETUC is ensuring the coordination and networking of the EURES trade union advisers who provide advice and councils to mobile workers in the framework of the EURES Network and more particularly to frontier workers in the EURES Cross Border Partnerships.

While not representing a significant part of the EU labour market (no more than 1.2 million, according to the European Commission), frontier workers bring an important contribution to the economy of several Member States, but they experience particular problems limiting their right to free movement across the borders.

In the framework of this project, we plan to carry out the 3 following activities:

ACTION 1) Annual Seminar of the EURES Trade Union Advisers: organization of a one-day meeting in Brussels

ACTION 2) Networking of EURES Cross Border Partnerships: organization of a one-day meeting in a border region, gathering several EURES Cross Border Partnerships

ACTION 3) Updating of the "Guide for European Mobile Workers"

Summary of the action

This proposal is meant to create a EURES cross-border framework between the Spanish region of Andalusia and the Portuguese region of Algarve, with the purposes of providing specific and personalised advice and guidance services to frontier workers and employers and remove the obstacles to cross-border mobility. I will support all the mobility flows of actual and potential frontier workers and employers, and will focus on all the business sectors which provide employment to all the target groups of this project. These sectors are the transport and trade industry, the healthcare sector (doctors, nurses, physical therapists, podiatrists), the hotel and tourism industry, as well as the construction and the agrifood sectors.

The proposal also seeks to increase the visibility of EURES in the cross-border area and reach out to a larger number of target groups.

It also sets the scene for the creation of a more integrated and dynamic labour-market with future specific recruitment projects which will take into account the concrete recruitment needs of the businesses of the cross-border area, provide more job opportunities to different categories of workers and address skills mismatch in the cross-border area.

It also ambitions to create a strong partnership structure which will progressively incorporate other key stakeholders in the cross-border area, which would jointly address cross-regional challenges in the field of employment.

Summary of the action

The application includes activities on priorities 1, 2, 4 and 8. The overall aim for all activities is to facilitate voluntary and fair labour mobility in the EEA countries, as well as support the work of the EURES network in EEA countries in line with the standards and procedures established in the EURES regulation.

The activities will also aim to pay particular attention to vulnerable groups, promote equality between men and women, combat any kind of discrimination and promote a high-level of quality and sustainable employment. Focus will be to ensure a transparent labour market with open exchange of job vacancies, applications and any related information for these target groups, as well as provide support services for the recruitment and placement of workers in employment.
