Information clause of the General Data Protection Regulation [GDPR] for students and doctoral students applying for social benefits

1. Personal data controller

The controller of your personal data is the University of Silesia in Katowice. You can contact the administrator in the following way:

2. Data Protection Officer

You may contact the Data Protection Officer in all matters concerning the processing of your personal data and the exercise of your rights relating to the processing of data as follows:

3. Purposes of the processing and legal basis of the processing

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is based on Article 6(1)(a), (c), (e) and Article 9(2)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

- 1) Your explicit consent to the processing of personal data (including data about your health condition, degree of disability) for the purpose of initiating proceedings to consider your application for benefits: i.e. social allowances, scholarship for the disable, financial aid, Rector's scholarship.

The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the submission and processing of your claim for benefits. If you do not provide your data, it will not be possible to achieve the above mentioned goals.

- 2) fulfilling the legal obligation imposed on the controller; performing a task carried out in the public interest, consisting in providing financial support to students and doctoral students (who started their doctoral studies before the academic year 2019/2020), in accordance with Articles 86 to 95 of the Act on Higher Education and Science, Article 281 of the Act introducing the Act on Higher Education and Science and the Rules and Regulations of Social Benefits For Students of the University of Silesia.

4. Retention period of personal data

We will keep your personal data for the period necessary for the implementation of financial support in

accordance with applicable laws and for archival purposes for a period of 5 years, in accordance with the Uniform Material File List of the University of Silesia.

5. Data recipients

We may transfer your personal data to entities processing them on our behalf and to public bodies and entities entitled to obtain data under the applicable law.

6. Rights relating to the processing of personal data

You have the following rights in relation to the processing of your personal data:

- 1) the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of your consent before its withdrawal. Withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data is tantamount to withdrawal of the application for benefits,
- 2) the right to access your personal data,
- 3) the right to request that your personal data which is incorrect be corrected and that incomplete personal data be supplemented,
- 4) the right to request the deletion of your personal data, in particular if you revoke your consent to the processing, when there is no other legal basis for the processing. This right does not apply if the processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of obligations under the law or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest,
- 5) the right to request a restriction on the processing of your personal data,
- 6) the right to object to the processing of your personal data, due to your specific situation, in cases where we process your data on the basis of our legitimate interest, including for direct marketing purposes, or for the performance of a public task. NOTE: in the case of processing for direct marketing purposes, you may object at any time regardless of the specific situation,
- 7) the right to transfer your personal data, i.e. the right to receive your personal data from us, in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable IT format. You may send this data to another data controller or request that we send your data to another controller. However, we will only do so if such a transfer is technically possible. You only have the right to transfer your personal data if we process the data in an automated way, i.e. in electronic form, on the basis of a contract with you or on the basis of your consent,
- 8) the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office,
- 9) your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.
