

Just transition research workshop

The aim of the workshop is to provide participants with basic knowledge about just transition on the basis of research problem matrix on just transition that includes actors and energy justice dimensions. Students will be accustomed with application of the matrix element i.e. labor-market case study. During workshop the study visit in urban areas touched by unjust transition, as well as revitalized areas will be organized. The result of the workshop is the research project prepared by participants and devoted to the just transition problems. The project should consist of research problem, research questions, and research tool referring to the matrix. The effect of the workshop would be research project ready to apply within frontline communities.
