



1. How to log in to the catalogue





2. How to apply to courses

As users with the T4EU student role, you will see the 'My Courses' tab in the top menu where you can view courses you are enrolled in, those you have applied for, and those where your application has been rejected.



For courses created as open to all T4EU students, a 'Go to' button will appear on the right side of the page, directing participants to the corresponding Moodle course or any other Learning Management System. Please note that if the link provided when creating the course points to a tool that is not federated, you will need to log in again.

Description
As we have seen, decision tables arise in different applications. So we study decision tables as an independent mathematical object. We begin our consideration from decision tables with one-valued decisions. For simplicity, we deal mainly with decision tables containing only binary conditional attributes.
