This seminar is geared towards students whose academic interests revolve around issues related to Foreign Language Education, Multilingualism, and Second/Third (Additional) Language Acquisition. The overarching aim is to guide students throughout their thesis writing process, while offering them opportunities to improve their critical and analytical thinking, their academic writing skills, as well as their ability to request, give and receive constructive feedback. Within the course of the seminar, students will thus explore a topic of their interest from a research perspective and will be required to plan, conduct, and report on the results of a small-scale study.

This seminar is aimed at students interested in topics related to Second Language Acquisition (SLA), with a particular emphasis on English Language Teaching. While research interests of dr Szymańska-Tworek have focused on aspects of English as a lingua franca and ELF-sensitive teaching, different aspects of teacher training, as well as non-native bilingualism, seminar participants are welcome to pursue issues relevant to their personal interests within the scope of SLA. The topics discussed in the course include the following: writing of the BA paper – an overview of the process; introduction to research methodology, methods of data collection and analysis; appropriate use of references and bibliography; academic writing; effective literature search; plagiarism; goal setting, managing time, keeping to deadlines, procrastination and writer's block. Course credits will be based on the evaluation of students' overall work and engagement throughout the course. Students will be expected to work systematically and efficiently towards the creation of their BA theses.
