REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ABSTRACTS OF REPORTS

Organizing Committee is accepting for consideration abstracts of reports up to 5 pages in Microsoft Word, Times New Roman type, skittle – 14, interval – 1,5, all page fields – 20 mm, paragraph indentation – 12,5 mm. First line – surname, name, given name; second line – scientific degree, academic status (for students – year of study, specialty); third line – position and name of the educational establishment; fourth line – topic of the report (capital letters, bold, centered); at the end of text – references (*references in the text are to be made as follows*: [7, p. 123], where 7 – source number in the list, 123 – page number). References to several sources simultaneously are to be made as follows: [1; 4; 8] or [2, p. 32; 9, p. 48; 11, p. 257].

THE ORGANIZATIONAL CONTRIBUTION IS NOT PROVIDED

For participation in the conference it is necessary to submit **no later than June 22nd, 2023** to the Organizing Committee address conferens2020@ukr.net:

- application for participation in the conference;
- abstract of the report (in Ukrainian or in English).

The file name must match the surname and name of the author, e.g.: Ivanov_application, Ivanov_abstract.

Participants without a scientific degree have to submit a certified review of their scientific supervisor.

Citation in the text and inclusion in the references of sources published in Russian in any country as well as sources in other languages if published in the Russian federation or Republic of Belarus is forbidden.

Abstracts which do not meet the abovementioned requirements or violate the submission deadline will not be considered or published.
